Our Dream - Our Gurudwara



The Sikh Foundation San Diego new Langar Hall construction has slowed down the past few months due to building permits and fundraising needs. Here are a few points from the presentation that was shared at the recent Diwali Diwan a few weeks ago.

The new Langar Hall Building that is in progress includes:

- Langar Hall
- Kitchen
- Punjabi School for Children
- The Sikh Foundation San Diego Library
- Residence for Bhai ji and Visitors
- Quarters

The next phase of the Building project at a future date will entail updates to current Gurudwara building of:

- Bathrooms
- Diwan Hall
- Facade
- Parking lot and Playground upgrade

Financials

The entire building project is projected at around \$1.5 million. Phase 1 accounts for about \$1.15 million. We have collected around \$850,000 so far and need approximately another \$300,000 to complete the Langar Hall, Kitchen, Punjabi Classrooms, Bhai ji and Visitor's Quarters. Phase 2 will begin after Phase 1 has successfully been completed.

The San Diego Interfaith 9/11 Memorial & Concert

The Sikh Foundation San Diego organized, participated and attended along with many other diverse faith groups from all around San Diego County a memorial for the tenth anniversary of 9/11 in the beautiful and serene setting of Balboa Park's Spreckels Organ Pavilion on Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011 from 4:30 p.m to 6:30 pm.

The **San Diego Interfaith 9/11 Memorial & Concert** was a collaboration of multiple San Diego interfaith organizations to promote and create a world, especially since 9/11, filled with understanding, acceptance, respect, dignity, peace and love for all. The theme was "*Responding from the Heart*" and the hope was that at the end of the hour and half program filled with spiritual music from many faith traditions interspersed with prayers from youth from the different faith

traditions would walk away touched in some corner of our hearts by a little more love and understanding.

Since the event was a united San Diego County wide event, over 1,250 people participated in this historic program. Hundreds of people also wrote prayerful messages on pieces of fabric that are being created into a memorial quilts that will later be exhibited throughout the San Diego community and one of the quilts will be sent to Ground Zero in New York City.

Dozens of religious leaders were invited to walk in the procession in the beginning of the event to the regal and majestic "*Trumpet Tune and Flourishes*" composed by David Maxwell. These religious leaders were also asked to write brief messages that were printed in the program book about what they learned from events during the past decade since 9/11 based on the theme of "*Responding from the Heart.*" Here are a few of the messages that were shared including one from our very own Arvinder Singh Malhotra:

"My heart is joyful because out of tragedy can come unlimited growth. In the past ten years, we have experienced a growing emerging community of varied religious and spiritually minded people coming together embracing the similarities and valuing the differences. We celebrate the oneness of all creation – we are One."

"A boat that had sailed for a long time, in calm waters, was suddenly thrown into a tumultuous storm on 9/11. No one was prepared. According to the organizers, the intent of the program was "ten years ago, the acts of a few took something very precious away from the many. During this 10th anniversary **San Diego Interfaith 9/11 Memorial & Concert**, we embraced what binds us as humans and it is Love—be it for our family, our friends, our neighbors, our country, our (church, temple, synagogue, mosque), our God or Divine, and all of the Divine's Creation. These expressions of Love reflect humanity at its best and this is what we are here to share and observe."

"To seek and strive for peace is just the beginning – the foundation. To transcend beyond peace to Love is to be God-like or in the image of the Divine. This is the goal of God-Loving people, isn't it? To see the Divine in not just the beauty of the flower, the vastness of the ocean or the laughter of a child but to see It even in those with whom we have very little or nothing in common whether it be looks, religious practices, language or any other noticeable differences. Perhaps, the barrier to achieving this Love is language which must be sought and found."

Hence, this 9/11 program tried to present a language of Divine Music and sacred Prayer from the mouth of babes, albeit with new sounds and different languages. David O'Brien, a Catholic historian, in a September CNN article said, "The story is not over, not by a long shot. Look at all the love that day. Love can still write another chapter and keep hope alive for a better future. The meaning of 9/11 lies ahead, and it's in our hands, and maybe in our hearts."

The Sikh community not only attended but contributed with all their heart to the program by singing a heart rendering shabad, "**Sabh Ko Aasai Tharee Bait(h)aa**" by Guru Arjan Dev performed in conjunction with the *Poway Interfaith Team*

and *The Sikh Foundation San Diego*. The Shabad was arranged and choreographed by our very own Hari Singh and accompanied by Subhag Singh, Dilraj Singh, Dishveen Kaur, and Simran Kaur on harmonium and with Karan Singh and Aman Singh on tabla. We are grateful to Hari Singh for his guidance and to Subhag Singh, Karan Singh, and Dilraj Singh for their time and effort in assisting with the eight weeks of practices of the joint choir.

Year 2011-2012 is now in session ☺. Thanks to Waheguru's Grace this year marks the 7th year of the Punjabi School. We've come a long way and it gives us great joy to announce that this year we have 56 students. In order to maximize their learning effort, five classes have been created and we have eight teachers. In addition, this year we have two Gurmat Classes with two Gurmat teachers. In these Gurmat classes, the students are taught the Sikh Baani's of *Japji Sahib* and *Jaap Sahib*. In order to deal with the vast amount of administration that such an endeavor requires, we have two administrators, as well as many volunteers trying to ensure that the Punjabi School runs seamlessly and that the students have a great deal of fun. *The Sikh Foundation San Diego* would also like to thank the students and their parents for making an effort each weekend and every day to encourage their children to learn our much loved language.

Parents are reminded to sign in their children when arriving at the Punjabi School and sign out when leaving at the end of the school day. It would also be very helpful if you could familiarize yourself with the School Calendar so that you know when you have Snack Duty and more importantly when your child has been assigned to recite Ardaas. Should you require any help in having your child recite Ardaas, please do not hesitate to contact us.

What is the Concept of Karseva in Sikhism?

Seva is short for the word **Karseva** and refers to "**selfless service**," work or service performed without any thought of reward or personal benefit and is performed by a **Sevadar**.

All Sikhs are encouraged by the Guru to perform Seva (selfless service). At the Gurudwara,

Sikhs are encouraged to engage in free selfless service by washing dishes, cleaning the floors, serving food, and wiping as well as organizing the shoes amongst other services.

Outside of the Gurudwara, Sikhs are also encouraged to help the community by volunteering in hospitals, senior citizen facilities, feeding the homeless, cleaning public parks or beaches and a myriad of other services. These selfless deeds are integral to a key principle in Sikhism known as **sarbat da bhalla** - working towards the "*common good of all*". For Sikhs, this means reaching out to serve and uplift all of humanity as an expression or devotion to the Creator. Many of the Sikh institutions such as **Guru-ka-Langar, kirtan, paath** depend on the performance of Seva by many in the congregation. This point is highlighted by the Guru in many places in the **Guru Granth Sahib**. The text below explain the spiritual benefits of doing seva and the ways in which one should perform it, focusing on the state of the mind when performing seva.

- "ਸੇਵਾ ਕਰਤ ਹੋਇ ਨਿਕਾਮੀ ॥ ਤਿਸ ਕਉ ਹੋਤ ਪਰਾਪਤਿ ਸੁਆਮੀ ॥ *One who performs selfless service, without thought of reward, shall attain his Lord and Master.*" ([SGGS p 286](#)) The Guru states that one who perform selfless service without desire for reward will certainly attain liberation. The need to be "desireless" ("nehkaami") is critical in making this action fruitful. When one does Seva, one should just do it without any thought for a return - think of it as a duty to the society.
- "ਸੁਖੁ ਹੋਵੈ ਸੇਵ ਕਮਾਈਆ ॥ *You shall find peace, doing seva*" (SGGS p 25) Doing seva bring its own tranquillity and serenity which you cannot find in doing anything else.
- In Sikhism, salvation and liberty are achieved through performing **Seva**, following Gurbani and reciting Simran: "ਕਰਿ ਸੇਵਾ ਭਜੁ ਹਰਿ ਹਰਿ ਗੁਰਮਤਿ ॥ *Do seva, follow the Guru's Teachings, and vibrate on the Lord's Name, Har, Har.*" (SGGS p 176)
- Finally, "ਵਿਚਿ ਦੁਨੀਆ ਸੇਵ ਕਮਾਈਐ ॥ ਤਾ ਦਰਗਹ ਬੈਸਣੁ ਪਾਈਐ ॥ *In the midst of this world, do seva, and you shall be given a place of honor in the Court of the Lord.*" (SGGS p 26)
