

SDSF Punjabi School Curriculum Guidelines

Duration: One Year

An important note for each grade: Syllabus completion will depend on the learning pace of the students (Class).

Grade 2nd syllabus

Listening: - To pronounce, enunciate and articulate words with these sounds, listen to:

- Muharni Sounds
- Rhyming words
- Punjabi Rhymes, Poems
- Stories of Punjabi culture
- Simple role-playing activities
- Daily classroom conversation in Punjabi and daily used words to build the vocabulary.

Reading: - all Matras

- Learn Kanna sound and read kanna words and sentences.
- Learn Sihari and Bihari sounds and learn to read sihari, Bihari words and sentences.
- Learn Onkar and Dulankarh sounds and read words and sentences with these sounds.
- Learn Horaha and Kanaurha sounds and read words and sentences with these sounds.
- Learn lanvan and Dulanvan sounds and read words and sentences with these sounds.
- Learn Bindi, Tippi and Addak sounds and read words and sentences with these sounds. practice all these vowels by reading more words and sentences.
- Learn Paari Haha, Rara, Vava and learn words with them.
- Learn Muharni sounds.
- Learn Numbers from 1 to 30 in Gurmukhi.

Grammar: (at very simple level introduction): These topics of the grammar can be taught and explained while reading stories and poems.

- Singular — Plurals
- Masculine — Feminine.
- Opposite — Words

Vocabulary: Daily used words

- Family relation and relatives
- 5 Senses
- Days of week
- Season
- Weather
- Natural disaster
- Directions

Speaking: Conversation in Punjabi

- Small sentences, news or story telling using daily used words and other speaking actives.
- Count till 30 in Gurmukhi.

Writing:

- Write Kanna, Sihari, Bihari, Onkar, Dulankarh, Lanvan, Dulanvan, Horaha-Kanaurha, Bindi, Tippi, Addak, Parri, Haha, Vava and the proper placement of these vowels and sounds, simple sentences, etc.

- Basic beliefs of Sikhi and Key concepts.
- 10 Guru Sahiban sakhis.
- Ardas (short) and Vidia vichari Shabad

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
