

# SDSF Punjabi School Curriculum Guidelines

**Duration: One Year**

*An important note for each grade: Syllabus completion will depend on the learning pace of the students (Class).*

## Grade 3<sup>rd</sup> syllabus

**Listening:** To pronounce, enunciate and articulate words with these sounds, listen to:

- Rhyming words, Punjabi Rhymes, and Punjabi Poems
- Stories of Punjabi culture
- Simple role-playing activities
- Listen News in Punjabi
- Daily classroom conversation in Punjabi and daily used words to build the vocabulary.
- Listen Numbers from 1 to 50 in Gurmukhi.

**Reading:**

- Read stories with the help of teacher and independently.
- Read poems with help and independently.
- Learn new vocabulary words and understand their meanings.
- Learn Numbers from 1 to 50 in Gurmukhi.

**Comprehension:**

- Answer questions about the stories and poems read.
- Fill in the blanks in the sentences with newly learnt vocabulary words.
- Use new words learnt in their own sentences.

**Grammar:** These topics of the grammar can be taught and explained while reading stories and poems. *(At very simple level to understand context):*

- Singular — Plurals
- Masculine — Feminine.
- Noun — Pronoun
- Adjective
- Verb — Adverb.
- Simple Sentence Building.

**Vocabulary:** Daily used words

- School and Education.
- Time
- Attires
- Geography
- Water resources
- Diseases

**Speaking:** Conversation in Punjabi

- Small sentences, news or story telling using daily used words and other speaking actives.

**Writing:** Writing words, opposite words, Small Sentences, and Paragraphs etc.

**Projects:** Do some craft projects correlating to reading, writing, listening, and speaking etc.

**Gurmat:**

- Core topics about 10 Guru Sahiban.
- Ardas (short) and Vidia vichari Shabad, Anand Sahib
