

SDSF Punjabi School Curriculum Guidelines

Duration: One Year

An important note for each grade: Syllabus completion will depend on the learning pace of the students (Class).

Grade 5th syllabus

Listening: - To pronounce, enunciate and articulate words with these sounds, listen to:

- Rhyming words, Punjabi Rhymes, and Punjabi Poems
- Stories of Punjabi culture
- Simple role-playing activities
- Listen News in Punjabi.
- Daily classroom conversation in Punjabi and daily used words to build the vocabulary.
- Listen Numbers from 1 to 100 in Gurmukhi

Reading:

- Read the textbook stories by themselves more fluently or with some help.
- Read from the textbook and explain their meaning in Punjabi with help or without help.
- Read to the class their favorite passages to the class with right expression and pronunciation.
- Learn new vocabulary words and understand their meaning in the context in which they are used.
- Memorize a poem from the textbook.
- Learn Numbers from 1 to 100 in Gurmukhi.

Comprehension:

- Answer questions about the stories and poem read.
- Fill in the blanks with the newly learnt vocabulary.
- Use words in their own sentences.
- Summarizing the books and stories in their own words.

Grammar: These topics of the grammar can be taught and explained while reading stories and poems. *(At very simple level to understand context).*

- Singular – Plurals, Masculine – Feminine, Noun – Pronoun, Adjective, Verb – Adverb,
- Proposition, Conjunction – Interjection, Proverbs – Idioms and Punctuation marks.
- Interrogative, exclamatory sentences Tenses – Present, Past and Future etc.

Vocabulary from Punjabi book & Name of Months

Speaking: (conversation in Punjabi)

- Daily classroom conversation in Punjabi
- Sentences, news, or story telling using daily used words and other speaking actives.

Writing: Essays

- Guru Nanak Sahib Ji, Guru Gobind Singh Ji, Visakhi
- My mother, My Father, My Friend or My School
- My favorite city or place

Gurmat:

- Gurmat Sikhya
- Ardas (Full), Shabad Vidia Vichari and Anand Sahib

Projects

- Write a poem using rhyming words.
- Write an invitation for the celebration of a special day.
- Translate your favorite topic from English to Punjabi (eg. Game, Science, recipe etc)
- Make a board game or Crossword in Punjabi
- Translate and illustrate a story in Punjabi or you can write your own short story.

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
